BIRKENHEAD WAR MEMORIAL PARK DRAFT MASTERPLAN

The draft masterplan for the BWM park is now open for public consultation.

Please have a look through the masterplan and let us know if we're on the right track, or have missed anything.

As soon as the masterplan is completed and adopted, we'll be able to get underway with the business case for a new multisport facility to replace the grandstand (the business case is a requirement from Councillors before we can receive funding for the new building). Consultation open until 14 April.

Submit urging a greater urgency for the development of this facility. Also while construction of the building is underway Calliope and the other clubs need Council to provide temporary premises together with adequate storage.
